
20/20 VISION WEEK # 1

Week #1: DEVOTED - Discipleship



As we learn about and live into our 20/20 vision as a church, what can the Early Church teach us about being the church together? We're looking to help develop crystal clear clarity about who God is calling us to be and what God is calling us to do throughout this teaching series.

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

1. Without looking at our website, Revolution App, or any other materials, what is the vision of Revolution Church? After hearing the answers of the group, discuss how close or distant the group's version of the vision was to the actual vision statement of the Church.

2. **Read Acts 2:42-47.**

We learned about two components that characterized the Early Church: PROCESS + POWER. What PROCESSES are involved in the Early Church's life? How is God's POWER evident?

3. Why do you think the processes of teaching, fellowship, giving, worship, and serving led to God's power in the Early Church? Take a moment and consider the way in which the processes mentioned in Acts 2:42-47 operate in your life. Which of these processes are evident or lacking? How has your engaging in these processes led to an abundance or lack of God's power in your life?
4. Notice there are two key PLACES that followers of Jesus are growing in their relationship in the Scripture reading. The temple and in the homes. Why do you think that God uses places beyond a worship setting for people to grow as a disciple? How have you experienced growth in your Renovation Group or other small groups that meet outside of a Sunday morning setting?
5. On Sunday, we learned Revolution has three layers of discipleship: (1) Sunday morning, (2) Renovation Groups, and (3) Renew Groups (either an R-Village women's group or a Band of Brothers Men's Group). Are there possibilities within your group for a Renew Group?
6. One of the key words in the passage comes in Acts 2:42 - "devoted." How will you increase your devotion throughout this coming year in terms of your discipleship/relationship with Jesus Christ? What processes listed in #2-3 can you improve upon, and how will you do so?

BE THE REVOLUTION

PROCESS leads to POWER. Being devoted to the discipleship process leads to more of God's power in your life.

RENOVATING THE HEART

They devoted themselves to the apostles' teaching and the fellowship, to the breaking of bread and the prayers (*Acts 2:42*).
